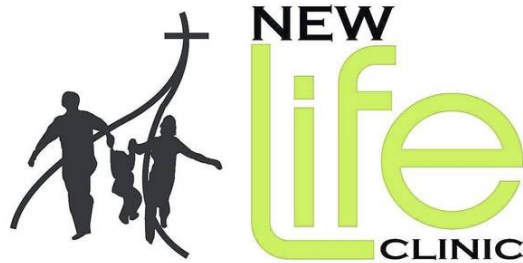

## 2024 THEME: PEOPLE OF THE TRUTH

KNOW THE TRUTH! GROW THE TRUTH! GO SHARE THE TRUTH!

John 8:31-32 says "If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples. Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free."

THEME: "LIVING A LIFE OF INTEGRITY" - Part 2

SERMON: "LOVE YOUR ENEMIES" - Matthew 5:38-48

- A. How do you treat the difficult people you encounter? Do you ignore them? Fake it and pretend to like them? Or do you deliberately try to get revenge and make their life miserable?
- B. In the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus asked His disciples to respond to antagonistic people differently than the world does. In fact, they were to respond counter to their own carnal instincts. "Don't resist an evil person, but turn the other cheek."
- C. With that in mind, let's look at this section of the Sermon on the Mount that talks about how we treat people who are difficult to live with.
1. First: Jesus mentions an evil person who **HUMILIATES** you.
    - A. Matthew 5:38-39
    - B. Deuteronomy 19:17-18
    - C. Romans 13:4
  2. Second: Jesus mentions an antagonistic person who **SUES** you.
    - A. Matthew 5:40
  3. Third: Jesus gives an example of an authoritarian person who **MAKES** unreasonable demands of you.
    - A. Mathew 5:41
    - B. Ephesians 6:5-7
  4. Fourth: Jesus gives another example of a needy person who **REQUESTS** money from you.
    - A. Matthew 5:42
    - B. Acts 3:1-8
  5. Fifth: Jesus gives an example of an enemy who **PERSECUTES** you.
    - A. Matthew 5:43-44
    - B. Romans 12:18
    - C. Romans 12:20-21
    - D. Matthew 5:48

CONCLUSION: Jesus had the power to strike his enemies blind, to paralyze their hands, to choke them on their own spittle, to condemn them to hell, but with divine dignity, He held his peace. He prayed, "Father, forgive them for they know not what they do." He did that so that our sins - our sarcasm, our reprisals, our injustices that we've inflicted on others - could be forgive. He was wounded for our transgressions; He was bruised for our iniquities and with His stripes we are healed.
