





Meal Before Sunday Night Revival



2024 THEME: PEOPLE OF THE TRUTH

KNOW THE TRUTH! GROW THE TRUTH! GO SHARE THE TRUTH!

John 8:31-32 says "If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples. Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free."

What's So Amazing About Easter? Luke 24

- A. Well, it's Easter! So what do you think you'll hear me preach about today? You know what! The resurrection of Jesus Christ . It's the crowning event of all history.
- B. So thanks for joining us for Easter Sunday morning. We are here to celebrate the resurrection of Jesus Christ together.
- C. In Luke 24, we find that on that Sunday morning, four women, who were followers of Christ went to the tomb.
 - 1. Luke 24:5-12
 - 2. Luke 24:39-43
 - 3. Luke 24:45-46
- D. This is amazing. In other words, Jesus pointed them all the way back to the Old Testament prophesies and Scriptures. He says, "Can I remind you of what has been promised and prophesied for hundreds of years?

So what's so amazing about Easter?

- 1. Well first, it had **<u>NEVER</u>** happened before.
 - A. Now the disciples had seen Jesus bring people back from the dead through His incredible power, but no one had ever resurrected themselves from the dead.
 - B. Eight different times in the Gospels prior to it happening, Jesus had predicted His own death.
 - 1. Flavius Josephus, a First Century Jewish historian, wrote about Christ's resurrection.
- 2. But it's also amazing because it **<u>COULD</u>** happen again.
 - A. So how could this resurrection thing happen again?
 - 1. Romans 3:10
 - 2. Romans 3:23
 - B. It could happen again, not because we deserve it, but because it's a gift.
 - 1. Romans 6:23a
 - 2. Isaiah 654:6
 - C. So we are faced with an earthly dilemma that begs for a heavenly solution.
 - 1. Romans 6:23b
- 3. What's so amazing about the Resurrection is: That it could happen to you **TODAY**.
 - A. 2 Corinthians 6:2
 - B. The resurrection of Christ was real and it has glorious implications for everyone who accepts Jesus as their Master and their Savior.
 - 1. 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18
 - You see what's so amazing about the Resurrection is that when Christians go to the funeral of another Christian, they don't have to grieve the way the rest of the world does.
 a. Philippians 1:21
 - C. Story of Beth and Dave and their trip to the "Tomb."
 - D. Why was the stone rolled away?

CONCLUSION: So what difference does the resurrection make? You know what, it means you can have a forgiven past. It means you can have a fresh start. It means that you can have a bright future. It means that you can have eternal life. It means that although death may take you, it can not keep you. When you accept Jesus and choose to live for Him and give Him your life, Jesus takes up residency inside of you. When you give Him your heart, He gives you His. That's the power of the resurrection. So whether you run to the empty tomb or whether you walk to the empty tomb, just make certain you get there. Read Romans 6:3-5
